The John C. Kluczynski Federal Building is a 42-story building located in downtown Chicago. This Federal Building is home to various government agencies. The building was completed in 1975.

The Kluczynski plumbing project consists of replacing all of the horizontal plumbing waste piping and domestic water piping located in 78 restrooms. The existing waste stacks are to remain and the domestic water risers that supply the restrooms on each floor will be replaced. The existing floor mounted water closets will be replaced with wall hung water closets. The restrooms are located on 39 of the 42 floors.

The existing water coolers will be replaced with electric water coolers, which are located on each floor.

Plumbing fixtures: 317 water closets, 76 urinals, 319 lavatories, 108 water coolers, 78 roof drains.
